Dear Community,

Wright County Community Action (WCCA) is committed to understanding the intricate details of our community. One way to do this is to strategically complete a full assessment every three-to-five years with a specific focus on the conditions of poverty in Wright County and the 18 western Hennepin communities we serve. We do this by surveying participants in our programs, the community at large, reviewing statistical data, and hosting conversations that allow us to inspect issues from every angle. However, we understand that a community can change dramatically in the meantime. For this reason, we commit to making annual updates to our assessment data. While we usually will not conduct a community-wide survey, or hold in-depth conversations, we will update the statistical information and report any significant shifts that have happened throughout the community. This letter is to inform you briefly on some of the trends we identified during the 2021 Community Assessment Update.

Declining Poverty Rate: The Wright County Poverty Rate is continuing to decline and now sits at 5.2%. However, it's important to note that over 7,000 individuals are still living in poverty. The percentage is only dropping due the high population growth that is experienced throughout the county. 44,452 individuals have moved to the county in the last 20 years.

Poverty vs. Low-Income: The Federal Poverty Guidelines state that those who live under 100% of the guideline are living in poverty, meanwhile those between 100% and 200% are considered low-income. This year's assessment shows that there are 18,781 low-income individuals in Wright County.

City Specific Poverty: We would also like to call your attention to page 62 of this report to review the city specific poverty rates. Geographical poverty is still relevant throughout our community.

Vulnerable Populations – Young Children: Again, the 2021 Assessment show a significant decline in children under the age of 5 who are living in poverty. This hard to count population brings unique challenges to being counted. We encourage you to review the 2019 Assessment Update to read about how the American Community Survey data doesn't reflect our boots on the ground experience.

Vulnerable Populations – Aging Adults: The number of seniors in poverty is one of the very few areas that grew (negatively) from our 2019 to 2021 assessment from 6.6% to 7.0% respectively. Nearly 70% of these seniors in poverty are women.

Third Grade Reading Scores – Due to COVID-19, the 2019-2020 MCA tests were not administered and data is not yet available from the 2020-2021 school year.

Thank you for taking the time to read our 2021 Assessment Update. We hope this information can help you identify goals for our community and inspire you to take action to fight poverty.





Population, Density (Persons per Sq Mile) by Tract, ACS 2015-19










Race Demographics




Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19








Population Below 200% Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19










Family Poverty Rate by Family Type



Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 5-17), Percent by County, SAIPE 2019






Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19








Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-4), Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19






Children in Poverty by Gender: Age 0 - 4




Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 5-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19








Population Below the Poverty Level, Senior (Age 65+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2015-19














Life Expectancy At Birth, Years by Tract, CDC and NCHS 2010-15











Average Work Commute Time (Minutes), Average by Tract, ACS 2015-19










Percentage of Adults Lacking Literacy Skills






Vacancy Rates








Evictions














Asthma Prevalence

Asthma (Diagnosed), Percentage of Adults Age 18+ by County, CDC BRFSS 2011-12




Broadband Access, Pct. Population in a High-Speed Internet Service Area by Tract, FCC June 2020



The graph above outlines the poverty rates by city throughout Wright County. The blue labels show the ACS 2019 poverty rate, and yellow labels indicate the ACS 2016 poverty rate. Over the last four years, Montrose has maintained the highest poverty rate throughout the county which also exceeds the state-wide poverty rate of 8.9%.

When looking at these numbers it's important to recognize that our rural communities have higher rates of poverty when compared to the eastern edge communities of Albertville and Saint Michael. These two communities represent a large section of our total county population which adjust the overall poverty rates down to low rate of 5.2%.
